## General information

The Summer School will continue the very successful tradition of the previous summer schools since 2005. It includes lectures, practical labs but also social events, an excursion and much fun. Apart from acquiring new knowledge in an informal environment, this is an excellent opportunity to meet lecturers and young people and strengthen your network.

The **topics of the school** are:

- topographic mapping from high-resolution satellite sensors
- change detection with focus on landcover / landuse, agriculture and ecosystems
- microwave remote sensing with focus on forestry applications
- natural hazards

The number of participants will be restricted to 50, with selection based generally on the date of registration. The registration fees include accommodation in shared room, meals, participation in the school, learning material, social events and an excursion (all costs covered). The fees are:

- 40 USD (only for participants from Vietnam)
- 80 USD (for all other participants)

The fees must be paid in cash in USD on-site in Hanoi, on November 1-5. But **registration should be downloaded from the WEB site of the school and sent, the latest by October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010**. Sent registrations will be confirmed by email, as well as the final decision on accepted participants.
